Headlines 2026 Exam Results

Strong outcomes in English and mathematics:

Three quarters of pupils achieved GCSE qualifications in both English and mathematics.

Secure mathematics outcomes:

81% of pupils achieved a recognised qualification in mathematics.

Positive English outcomes:

81% of pupils achieved a recognised qualification in English.

Strong achievement across core GCSEs:

31% of pupils achieved five GCSEs.

Secure achievement of key benchmarks:

31% of pupils achieved five GCSEs including English and mathematics.

Broad qualification success:

56% of pupils achieved five qualifications or recognised awards at Entry Level or above.

Inclusive curriculum impact:

Pupils achieved qualifications across a broad range of academic, vocational and personal development pathways.

Strong science outcomes:

All pupils entered for GCSE Combined Science achieved the qualification.

Exceptional individual achievement:

One pupil achieved a particularly strong suite of GCSE results, including Grade 7 in English Language, Grade 5 in Mathematics, Grade 4 in Statistics, Grade 4 in Religious Studies and a 5-4 in Combined Science.

Personal development milestone:

Several pupils successfully completed the Silver Duke of Edinburgh's Award, the first time pupils from the academy have achieved the Silver Award.
